This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate order or direction especially in the nature of quashing of impugned orders dated 22.09.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.1; order dated 02.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2; and order dated 20.11.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that inadvertently order dated 20.11.2018 (Annexure P-1) has been annexed alongwith the present writ petition, although, the same pertains to a suit for rent recovery No.13/20.05.2015 and is not with respect to Ejectment case No.1 of 21.01.2015 and thus, seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after annexing and challenging the order which has been passed in Ejectment case No.1 dated 21.01.2015 and also after giving full and better particulars.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
