Present writ petition has been filed for quashing of the impugned Award dated 17.12.2019 (P-8), whereby respondent No.2 instead of sending the reference to the Principal Civil Court under Section 3(H) 4 of the National Highways Act, 1956 rejected the claim of petitioners.

This Court on March 15, 2023, passed the following order:-

“Learned State counsel, while making reference to Preliminary Submissions of the reply dated 16/17.05.2022, has pointed out that reference under Section 3(H) 4 of the National Highways Act, 1956 has already been referred to the Principal Civil Court; however, he seeks time to verify the status thereof.

Posted on 20.03.2023.

Be shown in the urgent list.

Fresh notices to respondent Nos. 1, 3 & 4 be also issued for the date fixed.

Dasti as well.

Till the next date of hearing, interim order to continue.”

Today, it is acknowledged by both sides that reference is pending consideration before the Court concerned for 29.05.2023.

In view of the above, learned counsel upon instructions from the petitioners does not press the petition any further.

Disposed off accordingly.

Needless to say that learned Reference Court shall proceed in the matter as per law, expeditiously.
