HARKESH MANUJA, J.

By way of present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner is seeking grant of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.307 dated 04.10.2022 for the offence under Sections 379-A IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 40, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case investigation has already been concluded and *challan* stands filed. He further submits that despite repeated reminders, the complainant is not coming forward for the purpose of test identification parade. He further submits that petitioner happens to be young lady of 22 years of age having an infant and as such, the concession of regular bail be extended in her favour.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the offence of this nature are increasing day by day in a society though, he further submits that there is no other case of similar nature pending against the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the paper book.

In the present case, the investigation of the case has already been completed, *challan* stands presented and as per information provided by the learned State counsel, it is correct that despite repeated reminders, complainant has not come forward for effecting his test identification parade. The trial is likely to take long time in this case.

Considering the facts that petitioner happens to be young lady of 22 years of age having an infant, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it may prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, nothing expressed hereinabove shall be construed as an expression on the merits of the case.
