Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.21 dated 18.01.2015 for the offences under Sections 307, 336, 188, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Patti (now Sadar Patti), District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits in compliance of order dated 09.01.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim

order dated 09.01.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to him, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to him.
