Main case

This is petitioner's fifth attempt to get bail during the pendency of a trial arising from FIR No.31 dated 03.02.2019, registered under Section 21, 22, 25, 27(A) and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was apprehended with 1008 intoxicating tablets containing prohibited substance under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. He is stated to have suffered incarceration for a period of 4 years and 4 months. However, the prosecution has filed an affidavit explaining that apart from FIR No.31 dated 03.02.2019, the petitioner is accused in as many as six more criminal cases including five under the Narcotic Drugs and

Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. As many as five cases are pending trial apart from the present one.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant concession of bail is made out.

Dismissed.
