Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to respondent Nos. 2 to 5 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family from the private respondent Nos. 6 to 13.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioners have approached the police authorities regarding ill treatment given to them by private respondent No. 6 i.e. their daughter-in-law. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that petitioners have submitted a representation/legal notice (Annexures P-3) dated 04.12.2022 to respondent No. 2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh and the same has not been decided till date. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that he would be satisfied if the said representation is decided.

Notice of motion restricted to respondent Nos. 1 to 5, only at this stage.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, AAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 5 and has no objection if the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is allowed.

In view of the above and with the consent of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2- Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh to decide the representation/legal notice

(Annexures P-3) of the petitioners after taking into consideration all the

relevants aspects, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

Present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
