The petitioner has filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 to 5 to grant protection to the petitioner as he apprehends imminent threat at the hands of private respondents. A further prayer was made to direct the police officials to take action against the accused in case FIR No.0185, dated 31.10.2022 under Sections 447, 427, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar and for immediately handing over the possession of the land measuring 11.5 acres to the petitioner, which is stated to be in illegal possession of respondent No.6.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner has confined his prayer only to the relief of grant of protection of life and liberty to him and his family members. He further submits that for the said purpose, a legal notice has already been issued to respondents No.2 and 3 and he shall be satisfied in case an appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3 to

decide the legal notice dated 13.12.2022 (Annexure P-4) for the purpose of said limited relief.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No. 3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural to look into the matter and take appropriate action as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.
