1. Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that on the oral request of the petitioners, the Finance Department, Govt. of Haryana through its Additional Chief Secretary, where the matter with regard to the release of the benefits under the 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission is pending consideration qua the employees of the Institution, be impleaded as party keeping in view the objections/averments made by the Institute in their reply.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection qua the said prayer.

3. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, on the oral request of the learned senior counsel for the petitioners, the Government of Haryana, Department of Finance through its Additional Chief Secretary is impleaded as a party as respondent No. 5 in the present petition.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of newly added respondent No. 5.

5. Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that keeping in view the reply filed, the matter is pending before respondent No. 5 for consideration as to whether, petitioners are entitled for the grant of benefit as admissible under the 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission, hence, respondent No. 5 be directed to expedite the said matter and pass an appropriate order on the said request in a time bound manner so that the petitioners do not suffer any further prejudice.

6. Learned State counsel submits that in case, the matter is still pending before respondent No. 5, appropriate decision as to whether, the petitioners are entitled for any benefit under the 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission as being recommended by the Institution, the same will be decided within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and the decision of respondent No. 5 will be conveyed to the Institution.

7. Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the

present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.
