Petitioner is seeking regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
in case FIR No.280 dated 26.06.2022 registered at Police Station Model
Town, District Panipat under Section 387 of Indian Penal Code, 1860
(Sections 120B, 216, 385, 387, 420, 465 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860
added later on.)

As per FIR complainant Sandeep Goyal received threatening
calls to eliminate him from mobile no.9996123450 in case demand of
₹20,00,000/- is not met.

The caller disclosed his name as Kalla Jatheri of Laurance
Bishnoi Gang. FIR was registered. It was found during investigation that
Ravinder @ Billu and Vikram had made threatening calls. The role of the
petitioner is that he is the seller of SIM card to Vikram from which the
call was made and said SIM was issued on the basis of fake

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documents.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that no role is attributed to the petitioner as far as threatening calls are concerned. Said factual position has not been disputed by learned State counsel. Petitioner is in custody since 05.07.2022.

Having regard to all the facts and circumstances as noticed above, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. As such, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Panipat.
