DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(Oral)

Petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.253, dated 19.05.2022, registered at Police Station Jind Sadar, District Jind, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 379-B of IPC (Sections 148 and 149 IPC were deleted later on and replaced by Section 34 IPC).

The attribution to the petitioner is that he along with co-accused Sunil @ Sonu, Kuldeep S/o Balbir, Ravi S/o Satbir, and Ankit S/o Rajbir had caused injuries with *lathis* and *dandas* on head and mouth of Bijender @ Kala and that in defence Bijender @ Kala also fired from a licensed pistol of Suresh, which had hit to Kuldeep and Sunil @ Sonu.

Although custody certificate has not been placed on record but learned State counsel on a query disclosed that the petitioner is in custody since 06.08.2022 i.e. for the last more than 5 months.

Considering the role attributed to the petitioner and the fact that from the opposite side, Kuldeep and Sunil @ Sonu also received fire arm injuries but without commenting further upon the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail and he is ordered to be released on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Area Magistrate/learned Duty Magistrate.
