This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction, especially writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside/quashing of the order dated 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the impugned order, the petitioner has an alternative remedy for challenging the impugned order under Section 201 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 and the petitioner thus seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition to avail the said alternative remedy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the

petitioner will file a revision petition under Section 201 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 within a period of one week from today and has prayed that respondent No.2 be directed to decide the same as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.

On filing of a revision petition by the petitioner under Section 201 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 within the aforesaid period, respondent No.2 is directed to consider the same as expeditiously as possible.
