ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 14.01.2015, vide which the parties were directed to maintain status quo.

It is admitted fact that subsequently, the writ petition was dismissed on 28.07.2017, holding that the petitioner has no locus standi to file

the same, as he has failed to prove that he was a tenant on the property as on 24.01.1971, therefore, the petitioner is not entitled to tenant's permissible area from the land of the big landowner.

Present contempt petition has been filed on 19.08.2017 i.e. subsequent to dismissal of the said petition alleging violation of the interim order dated 14.01.2015.

In view of judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Kanwar Singh Saini Vs. High Court of Delhi, 2012 (4) SCC 307**, once the case is finally decided, the interim order automatically stands nullified.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.
