The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents for execution of non-bailable warrants issued against respondent No. 9 to 12 dated 10.11.2022.

In compliance of order dated 06.02.2023, learned State counsel has furnished short reply by way of affidavit of Raj Kumar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, PBI (Economic Offence & Cyber Crime), Ludhiana and the same is taken on record, wherein it has been stated that the inquiry with reference to the representation made by the complainant is being looked into and shall be taken to logical conclusion.
