Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for compassionate appointment.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner's father was employed on a Class IV post as a Sweeper in the office of respondent No.3 and he unfortunately expired on 20.02.2021. Counsel submits that the deceased had put in more than 25 years of service and despite an application/representation dated 31.03.2022, Annexure P-5, submitted by the petitioner for appointment on compassionate basis, no action has been taken by the respondents. Counsel submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the application/representation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A. G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call upon the respondents to file a response.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without examining the claim of the petitioner, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to examine the representation, Annexure P-5, in the light of Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2019, within a period of 04 months and pass an appropriate speaking order.
