Instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of lives and liberty of petitioners from the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 8.

On 11.01.2023, following orders was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioners seeks a short adjournment to get instructions from petitioner No.2, as to how much amount as security for his daughters, he is ready to deposit in the shape of FDR in their names.

Adjourned to 23.01.2023. ”

On 23.01.2023 also there was no representation on behalf of petitioners and following order was passed:-

“Despite the case having been called twice, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 25.01.2023.

However, it is made clear that on the next date of hearing, case would not be deferred for further hearing.”

Today again, there is no representation on behalf of counsel for petitioners.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
