This petition is pending since 2018 and the petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 21.09.2017, passed by this Court in CR-6429-2017, vide which, a challenge was laid to the orders passed by the trial Court as well as the lower appellate Court deciding an application, filed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC, and it was directed by this Court that the parties will maintain *status quo* regarding possession and alienation of the suit property.

Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record a copy of the judgment dated 26.11.2021, passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Bholath, vide which, the suit filed by Gurmit Singh and petitioner Balvir Singh stands dismissed.

In view of the same, the aforesaid civil revision itself become infructuous, as it was arising out of the order passed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC and since the main suit stands dismissed, the same merges into

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the final order.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail his alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so avised.
