1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for disobeying the order dated 01.05.2018 and 19.07.2018 passed in CWP-10627-2018.

2. Learned Senior Counsel for GMADA has submitted and has produced the photographs showing that pursuant to the orders dated 01.05.2018 and 19.07.2018 passed by this Court, necessary action has been taken and necessary cleaning has already been done.
