This petition is pending since 2018 and as per direction of the writ Court dated 17.08.2011, revenue authorities were directed to complete the process and publish the final Record of Rights within a period of two years.

As per affidavit of Tehsildar Sale, Sonipat, on receiving the report from the Halqa Patwari on 03.05.2023, it is informed that land in question, qua which the petitioner and others, are staking claim, has been entered as shamlat deh, as per the order dated 11.08.2006 passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Rohtak, therefore, mitigation cannot be sanctioned in favour of the petitioner.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so required.
