For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the documents annexed with the application i.e. MRI report and OPD card are taken on record as Annexures P-5 & P-6 subject to all just exceptions.

CRWP-161-2023

The instant petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking extension of parole, as had been granted to him vide order dated 13.01.2023 (Annexure P-3), for another 2 months on account of his deteriorating health.

At the time of notice of motion on 10.01.2023, this Court had extended parole upto 20.01.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has serious spinal issues and may require to be operated upon. Learned

counsel has today produced a photocopy of the latest prescription slip/OPD slip issued by the Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh, where the petitioner had been examined yesterday and has been advised MRI of whole spine. In the said slip, it has also been recorded that the petitioner had infact been advised surgery way-back in October, 2022.

The petitioner is also present in person and going by his physical appearance, he certainly looks to be in bad shape.

In view of the aforestated position, the petition is accepted and the parole, as already granted to him vide order dated 13.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) and subsequently extended vide interim order dated 10.01.2023 is further extended for another 2 months.

The petitioner after availing parole shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on the morning of 01.04.2023.

The petition stands accepted accordingly.

Since it has been informed that the appeal filed by the petitioner i.e. CRA-S-613-2020 is pending in this Court, needless to mention, it shall be open to the petitioner to move an appropriate application for suspension of his sentence.
