By way of this petition, petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.32 dated 03.04.2022 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Jalandhar Cantt., District Jalandhar.

Custody certificate of the petitioner as well as status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Babandeep Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sub Div-V, Cantonment, Jalandhar have been placed on record by learned State Counsel. As per custody certificate, petitioner is in custody for the last 5 months and 24 days.

As pointed by learned counsel for the petitioner, the only attribution to the petitioner as emerged in the statement of injured Sumit is injuries with datar upon right arm and on the wrist. As per the MLR to be read with the medical report, the injury has been found to be grievous. The injury which has been declared dangerous to life is not attributed to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing

personal bail bonds and surety bonds tot eh satisfaction fo learned trial
