The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 28.02.2018 passed by the Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Town and Country Planning Department vide which it was directed that the petitioner/Association will get the permission under the Policy dated 23.01.2014 and submit a copy of the same to the DTP Enforcement, Gurugram within 90 days of the receiving of the order and till the time, the impugned order was stayed. It was further observed that if the petitioner failed to submit the permission in that case the DTP Enforcement can take further action as per the order dated 06.09.2017.

Reply by way of affidavit of the District Town & Country Planning/respondent No.4 is on record and as per the reply, it is stated that within a period of 90 days i.e. upto 31.05.2018, no permission was produced by the petitioner and therefore, after granting ample time to

apply for permission of erection of gates as per the Policy dated 23.01.2014, the gates were removed by respondent No.3 as the same were installed in an unauthorized manner.

In view of the above, no willful disobedience is made out.
Dismissed.
