Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.346 dated 02.11.2020, under Section 506 IPC and Section 67 of Information Technology (Amendment) Act 2008, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala, alongwith all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that dispute is between husband and wife. He submits that on the basis of false and frivolous allegations, earlier a complaint was lodged and enquiry was conducted and the same was not found to have been substantiated and thereafter the present FIR has been lodged. He submits that at present the learned trial Court has already framed the charges and case is fixed for examining the prosecution evidence. He submits that complainant is intentionally not appearing before the trial Court. He fairly submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition but the trial Court
