Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, '*the Cr.P.C.*') for directing respondent No.2 to further direct respondent No.3 for conducting fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.38 dated 20.06.2022, under Sections 452, 448, 323, 427, 506, 511, 148 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, '*the IPC*'), registered at Police Station Sadar Kurali.

2. Status report filed by way of affidavit of Dr. Sandeep Kumar Garg, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) dated 25.09.2023, is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite side.

Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. For reference, para 6 of the aforesaid affidavit is recapitulated as under:-

“6. That upon completion of investigation, final police report U/s 173 Cr.P.C. was prepared against respondent No.4 and 5 on 13.09.2023 and presented before Ld. Competent Court on 18.09.2023. Now the matter is pending before the Ld. Competent Court on 17.10.2023. So far as unknown accomplices of respondents no.4 & 5 are concerned, it is submitted that nothing could be revealed as regards them from the investigation of respondent no.4 & 5 or the photographs produced by petitioner, however, when in near future these unknown persons who were allegedly involved with respondents no.4 & 5 in the present occurrence would be found during the course of further investigation, on completion of investigation supplementary final report U/s 173 (8) Cr. P.C. would be prepared against them and presented before the Ld. Competent Court.”

4. Perusal of the above extract reveals that after completion of the investigation, report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. has already been submitted qua respondent Nos.4 & 5 as well on 13.09.2023 and the same is pending for consideration on 17.10.2023.

5. In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter.

6. Disposed off accordingly.

7. Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to raise her plea before the Court concerned, as per law.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed off.
