As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹7,50,000/- (₹ Seven Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1 - Gurdeep Kaur widow of Ramji Lal.

Though MACT has also given compensation to proforma respondent No.4 i.e. mother of the deceased, however, she has not filed any appeal before us. She is only proforma respondent and nobody has come present to contest on her behalf.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹7,50,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 - Gurdeep Kaur widow of Ramji Lal with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 07.07.2023, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company.
