The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 03.08.2021, passed by this Court in CR-3483-2012, vide which, *status quo* was directed to be maintained with regard to possession over the suit property.

The petitioner alleges that respondents were not in possession of the property in dispute, however, on 15.08.2012, they forcibly trespassed into the land and ploughed the same. It is further submitted that the respondents destroyed the sugarcane crop standing in the suit land.

Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record a copy of judgment dated 07.10.2017, passed by the JMIC, SBS Nagar to submit that respondent Jaspal Singh was an accused in FIR No. 20 dated 15.02.2013, registered under Sections 447, 511, 427, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr and after facing full length trial, the trial Court held respondents Jaspal Singh, Nirmal Kaur, Daljit Singh and two other family members, namely Taranjit Singh @ Bunty and Sukha Singh, guilty of committing offences punishable under Sections 447, 506,

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427 of the IPC and released them on probation, on furnishing bonds in the sum of Rs. 5,000/- each for a period of three months.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.
