In view of affidavit of Director Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, Directorate of Health & Family Welfare, Punjab, Parivar Kalayan Bhawan, Sector 34-A, Chandigarh filed on behalf of respondent No.2, the necessary compliance has been made.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that minimum of pay scale (at the lowest grade, in the regular pay-scale), extended to the regular employee holding the same posts, is not granted.

There is no such pay scale mentioned in the order in the judgment itself, the interpretation made by the State cannot be held to be a wilful disobedience.

Dismissed with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternative remedy, if so advised.
