MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of impugned order dated 27.08.2019 (P-3), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sunam in a Complaint bearing CIS No.Nact-1061-18, whereby petitioner was declared as a proclaimed person.

(2) The then Coordinate Bench, while issuing notice of motion on 13.01.2020, passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 21.04.2020.

Proceedings before the Ld. Trial Court shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.”

(3) Thereafter, on 24.07.2023, the aforesaid order was modified in the following terms:-

“On request of learned counsel for the petitioner, posted for 22.08.2023.

In the meanwhile, order dated 13.01.2020 is modified to the extent that petitioner shall surrender before learned trial Court within 02 (two) weeks from today. Upon doing so, he be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing subject to payment of Rs.24,000/- (Rupees twenty four thousand only), and on his furnishing bail and surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned.”

(4) Despite sufficient opportunities, petitioner has neither joined the proceedings before learned trial Court; nor paid the amount of Rs.24,000/-.

(5) In view of the above, there is no option except to dismiss the present petition.

Ordered accordingly.

(6) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
