Through this second petition (the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 19.04.2021), the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.385 dated 23.09.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad, under Sections 302 and 450 IPC.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that out of 18 prosecution witnesses, 13 witnesses have been examined.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied, if the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial at the earliest.

In view of the above and considering the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for the last 05 years and 10 months, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to make the best endeavour to conclude the trial at the earliest.
