The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.600 dated 09.11.2022 under Sections 380 & 457 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, (Section 411 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station City Fatehabad.

Vide order dated 11.01.2023, petitioner was granted the concession of anticipatory bail on the following terms:-

'Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was nominated as an accused pursuant to the disclosure statement made by main accused, who allegedly committed theft of LCDs from the hotel of the complainant. Learned counsel submits that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he allegedly purchased two LCDs from the main accused.'

He further submits that in compliance of order dated 11.01.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Rajender Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 11.01.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to him, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to him.
