Through instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Code, 1973, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.107 dated 08.12.2022 registered at Police Station Women, District Patiala (Punjab), under Sections 406 and 498A of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The petitioner vide order dated 10.01.2023 was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mandir Singh, submits that petitioner has already joined investigation and no custodial interrogation is required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.01.2023 is made

absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

If the petitioner or his family members/associates make any attempt to threat/intimidate the witnesses in the present case, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail granted by this order.

Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed as expression of opinion of this Court on merits of the case and Trial Court shall proceed without being prejudiced by observations of this Court.
