HARKESH MANUJA, J.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.246 dated 11.11.2022, under Sections 176, 177, 181, 198, 200, 205, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

On 18.01.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the petitioner was never involved in the previous incident wherein the documents were forged in the name of the complainant for the purpose of submitting surety bonds as the alleged act was committed by one Tarlok Singh and other two persons and the petitioner was never involved therein.

Notice of motion for 27.03.2023.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. D.A.G. Punjab who is present in the Court, accepts the notice on behalf of respondent-State.

In the meanwhile, petitioner will join investigation before the Investigating Officer as and when called. In the event of his arrest, the

Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Parambir Singh, submits that in compliance of aforesaid order dated 18.01.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further interrogation.

Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed. Order dated 18.01.2023 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.
