Reply on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4 filed in the Court is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioners submit that as per the reply, permission has been granted to petitioners No.2 and 4 to join the duty subject to final outcome of CWP No.19083 of 2017 and the petitioners No.1 and 3 have also been allowed to join their duties vide order dated

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04.10.2023 and 06.10.2023, respectively however, the salary for the intervening period has not been paid.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
