By way of this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.109 dated 24.11.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana.

As was agreed between the parties, matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Report has been received as per which parties have settled their dispute amicably vide settlement dated 19.07.2023.

In view of the above, the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail. Therefore, it is directed that on appearance of the petitioner before the Investigating Officer, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and

when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall further comply

with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, the respondent- State/complainant will be at liberty to approach this Court for cancellation of bail, in case there is violation of any of the terms and conditions of the settlement arrived at between the parties.
