This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to get conducted investigation of FIR No.179, dated 07.08.2019, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 376, 120-B IPC and Section 4 of POSCO Act, 2012, at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi District Kapurthala, from some investigating agency other than the District Police of Sultanpur Lodhi.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the main accused has been acquitted by the learned trial Court vide order dated 27.02.2020, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
