Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to release the retiral benefits i.e. Leave encashment, gratuity and commutation of pension alongwith interest. A direction has been sought to respondent No.2 to decide the status of suspension period of the petitioner from 31.12.2020 to 10.05.2022 i.e. the date of compulsory retirement and further to decide the charge-sheet issued vide Memo No.6/16/2021-51E dated 23.07.2021.

State counsel has placed on record a zerox copy of Memo No. 6/16/2021-51E dated 12.01.2023, and has submitted that a notice was issued to the petitioner and he has been personally heard on 16.01.2023.

Still further, he submits that by an order passed in the same day, sanction has been given for the payment of leave encashment and dearness allowance. State counsel has also placed on record, a copy of Memo dated 17.01.2023, to submit that the suspension period of the petitioner has been ordered to be treated as period spent on duty for the purpose of pensionary benefits and suspension allowance has been ordered to be released.

In view of above development, primary grievance of the petitioner is redressed. Writ petition is disposed of.

It is expected that the disciplinary proceedings will be concluded as expeditiously as possible.
