Grievance as has been raised in the writ petition pertains to a illegal activity being carried out by respondent No.8 in violation of not only the policy of the Government of Punjab relatable to the running of the marriage palaces, the excise policy etc. but also in an area where such activity is not permissible. Highlighting this aspect, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.11.2022 (Annexure P-5). The said representation till date has not been responded to.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the representation as referred to above within some specified time.

Without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, we dispose of the present petition with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 12.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Learned counsel for the State has pointed out that this representation has only been addressed to respondent No.1.

Let the other authorities consider the said representation at their own level which has been appended along with the writ petition and take a decision thereon.
