Reply to the writ petition has been filed by respondents, wherein it has been stated that the representation of the petitioner for deposit of the amount as per the counter offer which was initially rejected by the petitioner, but subsequently has not been accepted by the committee constituted to look into the said aspect. The said decision has been conveyed to the petitioner vide communication dated 24.01.2023 (Annexure R-2).

Counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the writ petition to challenge the said order. He further contends that during the pendency of the writ petition, Policy dated 10.02.2023, has been floated by the respondent-Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, where such like persons, as the petitioner have been given an opportunity to regularize their accounts subject to certain conditions as

have been laid down in the said Policy. Petitioner is ready to accept the terms and conditions in the said Policy and therefore would move an appropriate application as per the said Policy and apply for the benefits accordingly.

In the light of the above, we dispose of the writ petition as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. In case, the petitioner applies in pursuance to the Policy dated 10.02.2023, on or before 14.03.2023, the said representation shall be considered and the competent authority shall take a decision thereon within a period of two months, without being impressed or overawed by the decision dated 24.01.2023 (Annexure R-2) sympathetically.
