This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 27.10.2021 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Development), Amritsar and order dated 22.04.2022 passed by respondent No.4 by which the inquiry has been ordered to be conducted of Gram Panchayat Sarai Amanat Khan, District Tarn Tarna.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since no final order has been passed in the said proceedings, thus, he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to take all the pleas, which have been raised in the present writ petition and are available to him, during the course of the said proceedings.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.

Needless to say that in case the final order in the said proceedings is against the present petitioner, it would be open to the petitioner to challenge the same in accordance with law.
