The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.389 dated 09.12.2022 registered under Sections 120-B, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Barara, District Ambala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 11.01.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 06.05.2023 by way of an affidavit of Anil Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Barara has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Dev Dass admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 11.01.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
