DEEPAK GUPTA, J.

The petitioners are seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.462 dated 27.09.2022 registered under Section 387 IPC (Section 506 & 120B IPC added later on) at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

FIR was lodged on the complaint of Amit Jain as per which he had received message on his mobile phone on 27.09.2022 from a person projecting himself to be Goldy Brrar and demanding ₹12,00,000/- otherwise complainant was threatened to be killed. An amount of ₹5,200/- was deposited in the account provided by the caller, which was found in the name of one Fiaz Alam resident of Bihar. The said account was linked with mobile No.8757806560 which is stated to be in the name of Ashu son of Ram Chander.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has no concern either with Goldy Brrar or with Fiaz Alam or with Ashu son of Ram Chander.

Upon notice of motion, reply has been filed by respondent-

State, as per which on 07.10.2022 the two petitioners were apprehended

and it emerged on their questioning that they were the real culprits inasmuch as mobile phone used in the occurrence was recovered from Md. Imran and whatsapp chat was found containing transactions of money. Disclosure statements were also recorded.

As per the reply of the State petitioners are not wanted in any other case. They are in custody for the last more than four months. Challan has already been filed. Case is triable by Judicial Magistrate First Class. Trial may likely to take time to conclude. Considering all these factual circumstances but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioners are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
