GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking grant of parole for a period of six weeks for agriculture purpose.

As per the reply filed on behalf of the State, the petitioner being a hard core prisoner had committed offence while on furlough on an earlier occasion and as such, he is not entitled to be considered for grant of parole again for a period of three years and would be entitled only after 3 years w.e.f. 04.03.2021 (date of arrest).

Faced with the aforestated position, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file afresh to the authorities concerned after completion of three years w.e.f. 04.03.2021.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Needless to mention, when the petitioner applies again for grant of parole on any ground, as may be available to him, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously, in accordance with law.
