AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of necessary directions to official respondents to arrest the accused persons-respondent No.5 and 6 in case bearing FIR No.155 dated 24.08.2019, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC (Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2012 added later on), at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

2. Fresh status report dated 26.08.2023 by way of affidavit of Sarbjit Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (West) Amritsar (additional charge) has been filed by learned State counsel. The same is taken on record. He refers to para Nos.7 and 8 thereof, which reads thus:-

“7.That it is submitted that during the course of investigation of the aforesaid case FIR No. 155/2019 (supra) it has come to notice that the accused Surinder Singh is using WhatsApp mobile number 829869913. Hence, a request letter bearing No. 938-5E dated 18.08.2023 has been written to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar for obtaining Call Details Record, WhatsApp IP address, Customer Application Form and current Tower location of this mobile number, which is awaited. Hence, further appropriate action shall be taken in the aforesaid case FIR No. 155/2019 (supra) after obtaining the above said information.

8. That it is respectfully submitted that the aforesaid FIR No.

155/2019 (supra) is under investigation, which is being carried out by the deponent in a fair and impartial manner. Sincere efforts are being made to arrest the accused persons in this case. The investigation of this case FIR No. 155/2019 (supra) is being carried out in a fair and impartial manner and the same shall be taken to its logical conclusion.

- 3. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed.
- 4. Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
- 5. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail of alternate remedy, if any, available to him, in accordance with law.
