In view of the request made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the hearing of the main civil revision petition is preponed from 21.03.2023 to today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the present civil revision petition, the arrest warrants issued to secure the presence of the petitioner No.1 was challenged. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the controversy raised in the present civil revision petition also came up for consideration in CR No.1017 of 2023 titled as Suraj Paul Dias vs. Vishal Gupta, which has been disposed of on
