SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This is a petition seeking regular bail in FIR No.381, dated 20.11.2022, under Sections 384, 388, 389, 34 of the IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Julana, District Jind, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged recovery of loan amount has already been effected, challan stands presented and the petitioner is aged about 43 years added with the fact that other co-accused persons namely Vandana has already been granted the concession of bail vide order dated 10.01.2023 passed by trial Court and Kavita and Bina have already been granted bail vide orders dated 19.12.2022 and 06.01.2023 (Annexure P-4 & P-5) passed by this Court in CRM-M-58289-2022 and CRM-M-60168-2022 respectively.

Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner, which is taken on record. According to the custody certificate, the

petitioner is behind the bars for the last 1 month and 24 days.

Learned State counsel has also confirmed that the challan stands presented and the case is now fixed for consideration on charge.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is behind the bars for more than 1 month wherein co-accused placed on the same footing have already been granted the concession of bail either by this Court or by the trial Court itself and the trial is likely to take some time, therefore, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In light of the above, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The present petition is, hereby, allowed.
