passed by this Court in CWP-10165-1992.

This contempt petition is pending since 2013.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the main writ
petition already stands withdrawn, vide order dated 27.05.2015, a copy
which is placed on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that while
disposing of the aforesaid writ petition on 27.05.2015, a direction was
issued to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner,
which also stands decided. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for
the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered
infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail his alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
