This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction for quashing the impugned notice dated 07.12.2022 (Annexure P-9) issued by respondent No.1/State Government as well as report dated 23.11.2022 (Annexure P-10) submitted by respondent No.3 and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the proceedings have not culminated into passing of an order, thus, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to take all the pleas, which are available to him in law, during the course of the said proceedings.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.

Needless to say that in case the order passed in the said proceedings is against the present petitioner, it would be open to the petitioner to challenge the same in accordance with law.
