he petitioner is alleging violation of the order dated 02.12.2010, passed by this Court in RSA-2034-2009, vide which, the parties were directed maintain *status quo* regarding alienation of the property.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 5 submits that under a *bona fide* belief, respondent No. 4 has executed an agreement to sell in favour of respondent No. 5, however, on coming to know about the aforesaid order, he has received back the money and no sale deed is executed.

In view of the above undertaking given before this Court, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of.

Rule stands discharged.

The parties will remain bound by the aforesaid order, till the final decision of the regular second appeal, pending before this Court.
