The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.88 dated 17.07.2022 registered under Section 21(b), 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act read with Sections 353, 186 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 224, 148, 149, 506 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Mohkampura, Amritsar.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that on the directions of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and are no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hardev Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 11.01.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
