Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to provide compassionate appointment to either of the dependent children of the deceased.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the widow of Late Shamsher Singh, EASI, who unfortunately expired on 23.02.2014 while in service, due to an accident. Counsel submits that the petitioner had approached the authorities vide letter dated 04.02.2015, Annexure P-3 requesting for providing of financial assistance and compassionate appointment, but she was told that as her children were minor and did not fulfill the eligibility conditions, her case cannot be considered. Counsel submits that after her children attained majority and acquired requisite qualification, fresh application dated 07.03.2022, Annexure P-10 has been submitted to respondent No. 2 which has been forwarded by him to respondent No. 3 vide communication dated 10.03.2022, Annexure P-11, but the matter is hanging fire. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner

will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to look into the representation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call upon the respondents to file a response.

Having heard counsel for the parties, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3, Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar to examine the representation dated 07.03.2022, Annexure P-10 and take a decision thereon by passing a speaking order within a period of 04 months from the date of communication of this order.
