1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr. PC with a prayer to direct the respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.41, dated 23.03.2022, registered under Sections 323, 452, 506, 120-B and 148 of IPC, Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

2. A short reply by way of an affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of respondent State and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in the present case, the investigation of the case has been handed over to Superintendent of Police, Punjab Bureau of Investigation, District Amritsar (Rural) and the investigation shall be conducted strictly in accordance with law. He further contends that the departmental action has already been initiated against the erring police officials,

who had not conducted the investigation properly.

4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition and is accordingly disposed off.
